NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949.

CHIPPING NORTON RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL.

The Chipping Norton Rural District Council (Over Norton) Diversion Order, 1956.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 9th day of January, 1957, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to create a public right of way on foot of a width of approximately ten feet passing across Over Norton Park from the point "B" (i.e. a point in Over Norton Park near the village of

Over Norton) to the point "C" mentioned below, as shown coloured green on the map annexed to the Order, and to extinguish on the 9th April, 1957, the public right of way of a width of approximately four feet passing across Over Norton Park from the point "A" (i.e. a point in Over Norton Park near the village of Over Norton) to the point "C" (i.e. a point in the Over Norton Park near the Chapel House Cross Roads in the Parish of Over Norton) as shown coloured brown on the map annexed to the Order.
