

Tonbridge Rural District.**Horsmonden Parish.**

No. 28. Road used as public path (C.R.F.) Goudhurst Parish boundary at Finchcocks Bridge N. to road A262.

Lamberhurst Parish.

No. 47. F.P. Goudhurst Parish boundary near remains of Scotney Castle N.W. to junction with Nos. 33 and 38 S.W. of Scotney Castle.

No. 49 (part). B.R. From W. corner of O.S. 386 to Goudhurst Parish boundary N.E. of Little Scotney.

SECOND SCHEDULE.**Rights of Way added.****Cranbrook Rural District.**

(a) Benenden Parish. F.P. S.W. of Mount-Le-Hoe to connect No. 27 with No. 73.

(b) Benenden Parish. F.P. Walkhurst Road at Burnt House E. to join No. 73 in Nine Acre Wood.

(c) Cranbrook Parish. B.R. W. side of Hartley Hill S.W. to Badgers Oak.

(d) Cranbrook Parish. Road used as public path (C.R.B.). Junction with road to Eggshell to N.W. corner of Starvegoose Wood.

(e) Frittenden Parish. F.P. Short length N. of Leggs Wood connecting Nos. 62 and 69.

(f) Goudhurst Parish. F.P. County boundary N. side of Ketley and Wardsdown Woods N. to road A21 at Flimwell House Farm.

Frittenden No. 18. F.P. Frittenden-Headcorn Road E. of Great Hungerden Farm to Little Bubhurst. Between second and third field gates, path to be shown S. of hedge.

Frittenden No. 24. F.P. Unclassified road S. of Manor Farm E. to junction with Nos. 25 and 26. Between fourth and fifth stiles, path to be shown S. of hedge.

Frittenden No. 82. F.P. Sand Lane near Catherine Wheel S.E. to F.P. 83. Between third and fourth field gates, path to be shown N.E. of hedge.

NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949.**WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL.****SURVEY OF RIGHTS OF WAY.****Borough of Halesowen and Rural District of Evesham.**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Worcestershire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-section (3) of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statement prepared under Section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way within the Borough of Halesowen and the Rural District of Evesham, being parts of the area of the said Council, by:—

(1) the deletion of certain footpaths and/or bridleways in the Parishes of Abbotsmorton, Aldington, Badsey, Bickmarsh, Bretforton, Broadway, Childswickham, Church Honeybourne, Cleeve Prior, Harvington, Hinton-on-the-Green, Inkberrow, Kemerton, Norton and Lenchwick, Offenham, Pebworth, Rous Lench, Sedgewerrow and Wickhamford in the said Rural District;

(2) the addition of certain footpaths and/or bridleways in the Parishes of Abbotsmorton, Bickmarsh, Broadway, Cleeve Prior, Inkberrow, Kemerton, Pebworth, and Wickhamford in the said Rural District;
