

## BRIDGE-BLEAN RURAL DISTRICT.

*Hoath Parish.*

F.P. Short extension northwards to County road of F.P.3 Chislet.

*St. Cosmus and St. Damian in the Blean Parish.*

F.P. From No. 63 at W. boundary of Hempshall Wood, E.N.E. to No. 69.

*Sturry Parish.*

F.P. Hawe Lane S.E., S.W. and S.E. through Broadoak housing estate to join No. 4.

## DOVER RURAL DISTRICT.

*Capel-le-Ferne Parish.*

B.R. Extension of B.R.6 S.E. between New Dover Road and Old Dover Road.

*East Langdon Parish.*

F.P. Martin Lodge, N. to Ripple Parish boundary, S. of Appleton Farm.

F.P. Extension of F.P.6 from Poison Down, N.E. to School.

*Guston Parish.*

F.P. (Known as Barnbye Road.) County road S.W. of Church, S.W. and W. to Roman Road (B.R.2).

F.P. Upper Road opposite new houses at Broadlees S. to join new F.P. in Dover Borough.

*Ringwold Parish.*

F.P. Cliffe Chalet S. along foot of cliffs to St. Margaret's-at-Cliffe Parish boundary E. of Hope Farm.

*St. Margaret's-at-Cliffe Parish.*

F.P. St. Margaret's Bay near The Hermitage, S.S.W. along top of cliff to join F.P.1A near the old lighthouse.

No. 8. Road used as public path (C.R.F.) to F.P. Petham Parish boundary at Red Wood Lees N.N.E. and N.E. to Thanington Parish boundary E.N.E. of Upper Horton.

No. 20. Road used as public path (C.R.F.) to F.P. A 28 at Nickle Cottages N.N.W. and N.N.E. to Nickle Farm.

No. 30. Road used as public path (C.R.F.) to F.P. N.W. edge of Denge Wood at junction with No. 6 S. and S.W. through Wood to Waltham Parish boundary.
