The owner, lessee or occupier, of any land on which the map shows a public path, or a road used as a public path, may apply to Quarter Sessions for a declaration that the map and statement are incorrect in any particular as specified in section 31 (1) of the said Act.

Any such application shall be made in accordance with the requirements of the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952, and notice of it must be sent in writing within 28 days after the date hereof to the Clerk of the Peace, Shire Hall, Warwick, and to the other persons specified in the said Regulations.
