

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*Boroughs of Rugby and Solihull**Urban District of Bedworth*

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-section 3 of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way maps and statements prepared under section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to rights of way in the Boroughs of Rugby and Solihull and in the Urban District of Bedworth by altering to "bridleway" the description of the ways described as "road used as a public path" referred to in the First Schedule hereto by the number allotted to them in the respective drafts rights of way maps and statements, and by altering to "footpath" the description of the ways described as "road used as a public path" referred to in the Second Schedule hereto by the said numbers.

The draft rights of way maps and statements for the said districts may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Shire Hall, Warwick, and also, so far as they relate to the undermentioned districts, at the places named opposite them.

The Borough of Rugby—The Town Clerk's Office, Rugby.

The Borough of Solihull—The Town Clerk's Office, Solihull.

The Urban District of Bedworth—The Council Offices, Bedworth.

Any representation or objection with respect to any of these determinations shall be made in writing addressed to the Clerk of the Warwickshire County Council, Shire Hall, Warwick, before the 6th day of April 1959, and shall state the grounds upon which it is made.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads used as public paths to be shown as bridleways.

In the Borough of Rugby—RB.10, RB.12.

In the Borough of Solihull—SL.84.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Roads used as public paths to be shown as footpaths.

In the Borough of Rugby:

RB.3b for so much of its length as lies to the west of Brownsover Mill, RB.4 so far as it lies to the east of Parkfield Road, RB.4a for a distance of about 15 yards to the east of Thurmill Road, RB.5 for so much of its length as runs north-westwards from the Leamington railway until it passes under the Birmingham and Nuneaton railways, RB.5a, RB.5b, RB.13a, RB.13b except the first 100 yards at the western end, FB.24 from a point about 30 yards north-east of the north-eastern boundary of the Rugby—London main line railway as far as "The Locks," RB.34, RB.35.

In the Borough of Solihull:

SL.10 from Barston Lane to a point about 100 yards west of Henwood Hall and from Warwick Road for about 360 yards, SL.12 for a distance of about 180 yards from Hampton Road, SL.18 for a distance of about 30 yards from its western end, SL.19 from Longdon Hall to the Birmingham Road, SL.26 except for about 550 yards at its western end, SL.29 except for about 620 yards at its northern end, SL.31, SL.32, SL.44 for about 230 yards at its southern end, SL.47 for about 170 yards at its eastern end, SL.52 for about 120 yards at its south-eastern end and about 240 yards at its north-western end, SL.56 for about 710 yards at its eastern end, SL.57 for about 275 yards at its northern end, SL.58 from a point about 200 yards from Shelley Lane eastwards for about 500 yards, SL.68 for about 200 yards from its eastern end, SL.69 for about 370 yards at its northern end, SL.71 for about 130 yards at its eastern end, SL.74 for about 350 yards at its southern end, SL.92, SL.93 for about 100 yards at its southern end.
