HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959**CHIPPING NORTON BOROUGH COUNCIL****NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**
Chipping Norton Borough Council (Portland Place) Public Path Diversion Order, 1962

Notice is hereby given that on the 27th day of February 1963 the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

Its effect is to divert the public right of way running from

Horse Fair to Albion Street at Portland Place, Chipping Norton from point "B" being a point approximately 93 feet east-south-east of Horse Fair and running in an easterly direction to point "C" thence in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 24 feet to "D" being a point approximately 92 feet west of Albion Street and coloured brown on the map annexed to the Order,

to a line running from

point "B" described above, in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 27 feet to point "F" thence in an easterly direction to point "H" on the map annexed to the Order being a point approximately adjacent to point "D" described above.

The new path is shown coloured green on the map annexed to the Order, its width will be 3 feet and approximate length 121 feet.

The extinguishment and diversion will take effect as from the 20th day of March 1963.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at The Guildhall, Chipping Norton, Oxon, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. and between 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

The Order becomes operative as from the 15th day of March 1963, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.

Pear Tree Row, Callington (Unclassified)
